**REMINDER..**



We are now part of Ocean County Hunger Relief. On the second weekend of each month (NEXT weekend) we will be collecting non-perishable food. The food collected will be delivered to one of the food pantries in Ocean County, used for our Visitation's soup kitchen or St. Vincent de Paul. Food is not distributed from Visitation. Receptacles are at all the doors of the Church. Items needed: milk, juices (no fruit drinks), canned fruit, jelly, dried fruits, raisins, unsweetened fruit, cereals (no sugar cereals), rice, spaghetti, pork and beans, canned vegetables, baby items, soaps, toilet paper, detergents, etc. Please check expiration dates.
